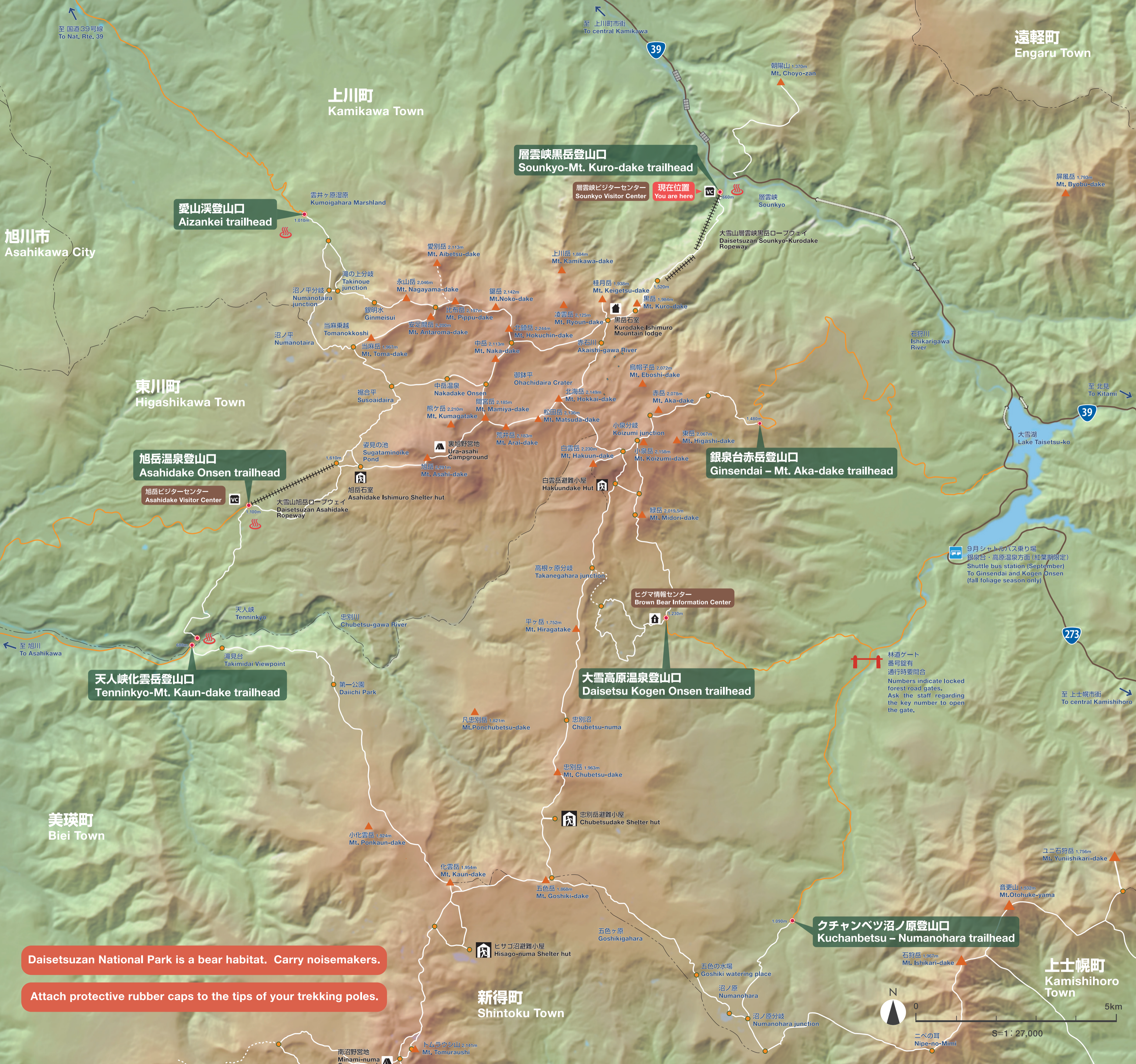


This map was prepared as a guide for climbers visiting the Visitor Center. It has been edited and processed based on basic map data (digital elevation model) and the Digital Japan Basic Maps (map data) of the Geospatial Information Authority of Japan. It may be printed out for personal use, but should be used as a rough guide only. Please note that indicated course climbing times may be affected by the weather, course conditions, and individual stamina.
